

The ILO-UIE Project on Seoul Broadcasting System, Korea



The Seoul Broadcasting System (SBS) in Korea is documenting a TV Story Program on Child Labour titled **"Happy Children in Bangladesh"**. The programme aims to sensitize and educate its audiences, especially Korean viewers, to understand the life of working children and their aspiration despite poverty.

The programme will illustrate lives of Bangladeshi children labouring to support their families and changes led by the outstanding effort and endeavor of many organizations in Bangladesh, especially the ILO-Urban Informal Economy (UIE) Project in Dhaka City Corporation.



The SBS team visited Multi-Purpose Centers and Vocational Training Centers of the Dhaka City Corporation's Action Programme on Child Labour, supported by the UIE Project to capture Non-Formal Education (NFE) and Skill Development Training (SDT) classes, interviews of NFE and SDT learners and graduates and parents of the working children, and employers

The programme is expected to broadcast in early March 2011.
