GENDER EQUALITY



WORKERS

(grade 4-7).

61% of all workers are women; 85% of them perform low-paid tasks requiring low skills



MANAGEMENT

5.8% factory owners, **4%** factory managers and **9%** supervisors are women



WORK DISTRIBUTION

Women mostly work in the sewing and finishing sections requiring

manual labour.

Men perform cutting, ironing, knitting and dying involving technical skills.



Women workers earn

11% less than men. Wage gap is **5%** for women supervisors.
