MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between the Ministry of Labour - Invalids and Social Affairs and the International Labour Organization, on the Cooperation to promote international labour standards in Viet Nam for the period 2021-2030

The Ministry of Labour - Invalids and Social Affairs (MOLISA) and the International Labour Organization (the ILO Country Office for Viet Nam) (hereinafter referred to as "the Parties"),

Recognize the role and the importance of promoting the application and implementation of international labour standards in Viet Nam, contributing to the development of the Plan for implementation and proposal for further ratification of ILO Conventions by Viet Nam during the period 2021-2030,

With the desire to enhance the close cooperation to promote the ratification and application of international labour standards in Viet Nam where appropriate, the Parties agree to present a Memorandum of Understanding on the Cooperation to promote international labour standards in Viet Nam for the period 2021-2030 (hereinafter abbreviated as MOU), demonstrating their mutual commitment and creating a formal cooperation framework between MOLISA and the ILO Country Office for Viet Nam in this important area,

The Parties agree as follows:

Article 1. Objective of the cooperation and the principles underlying it

1. The objective of the cooperation

The Parties cooperate to promote the ratification and implementation of international labour standards in Viet Nam for the period 2021-2030 through the establishment and implementation of a cooperation framework between MOLISA and the ILO Country Office for Vietnam.



2. The principles underlying the cooperation

The Parties cooperate to implement this MOU in a respectful, goodwill and constructive manner and in compliance with Viet Nam's legislation and international treaties to which Viet Nam is a signatory.

Article 2. The general scope of the cooperation

- 1. Enhance the social awareness of the international labour standards and their practices in Viet Nam.
- 2. Cooperate in the implementation of activities to internalize the ILO Conventions ratified by Viet Nam into Vietnamese law, and to enforce the Conventions in Viet Nam.
- 3. Enhance the capacity of relevant agencies of Viet Nam to apply international labour standards.
- 4. Cooperate in promoting the capacity of relevant agencies of Viet Nam to fulfill their reporting obligations on implementation of ratified ILO Conventions.
- 5. Cooperate in monitoring the implementation of ILO Conventions ratified by Viet Nam.
- 6. Continue to undertake studies and develop proposals for the ratification by Viet Nam of further relevant ILO Conventions.
 - 7. Cooperate in other areas of mutual interests.

Article 3. The scope of the cooperation in particular

- 1. Disseminate and enhance awareness of the ILO Conventions that Viet Nam has ratified and other Conventions of mutual interests.
- 2. Enhance the enforcement of ILO Conventions that Viet Nam has ratified, that includes the enforcement of ILO Conventions under the framework of new generation of free trade agreements to which Viet Nam is a signatory, and develop the content and a roadmap for the internalization of the ILO Conventions into national legislation and for their enforcement.
- 3. Ensure the participation of social partners (representing workers and employers) in the application and fulfillment of reporting obligations of implementing international labour standards
- 4. Promote the fulfillment of the regular and ad-hoc reporting obligations for implementation of ILO Conventions that Viet Nam has ratified and improve the quality of reporting in terms of national legislation and national practices.

The Table of reporting obligations of Viet Nam on ILO Conventions for the period 2021-2026 is attached as Annex 01 to this MOU.

- 5. Develop a system to monitor and evaluate the enforcement of ILO Conventions that Viet Nam has ratified.
- 6. Propose a roadmap and develop recommendations to promote the ratification of ILO Conventions which Viet Nam has not yet ratified based on strategic considerations, taking into account the national interests, foreign relations, and international commitments of Viet Nam.

The List of ILO Conventions to be studied and proposed for ratification for the period 2021-2030 is attached as Annex 02 to this MOU.

Article 4. Responsibilities of the Parties

- 1. The Parties will develop, agree and cooperate to implement specific cooperation activities in realization of their commitments under this MOU.
- 2. The Parties agree to cooperate in good faith, to mobilize resources and assist each other in the implementation of the activities within the framework of this MOU in accordance with its respective rules, procedures and policies.

Article 5. Implementation of the MOU

- 1. The Parties will regularly track the progress of agreed activities, and periodically evaluate the implementation of the MOU.
- 2. The Department of Legal Affairs of MOLISA will be focal point, and in collaboration with Department of International Cooperation of MOLISA, will be undertaking the task of cooperating with the ILO Country Office for Viet Nam to coordinate and implement the activities outlined in this MOU.
- 3. The Parties will hold regular consultations with the employers' representative organizations and workers' representative organizations on issues relevant to the implementation of this MOU.
- 4. Any differences related to the implementation of this MOU will be discussed and agreed between the Parties through consultations or negotiations

Article 6. Amendment of the MOU

This MOU can only be amended by written agreement between the Parties. Any amendment shall constitute an integral part of this MOU.

Article 7. Effect of the MOU

- 1. This MOU is not an international treaty; therefore, it does not constitute a binding obligation for Viet Nam in accordance with international laws.
- 2. Following consultation between the Parties, this MOU may be terminated by either Party by written notice to the other. The MOU will become invalid 30 days after the Party's receipt of such written notice from the other.
- 3. All disputes between the Parties related to this MOU will be resolved by joint negotiation between the Parties.
- 4. This MOU will come into force on the date of its signing by both Parties and will remain into force until 31 December 2030, unless terminated as per clause 2 of this Article.

This MOU is signed in Hanoi, Viet Nam on 20th May 2021 and is made into two sets of which each Party shall keep one. Each set includes a version of the MOU in Vietnamese and a version in English.
