## Calculations based on updated figures up to 1 January 2014

Table 1 shows the list of countries which are major maritime countries. Column 1 shows the changes that took place in consumer prices between 1 July 2011 and 1 January 2014, the period to be used for adjustment, Columns 2 and 3 present the average exchange rates as at 1 July 2011 and 1 January 2014, and column 4 shows the purchasing power equivalent on 1 January 2014 of 585 US dollars on 1 July 2011 in the 57 selected countries and areas.

Table 2 contains the resulting data from column 4 of Table 1 arranged in ascending order of magnitude. The median is then calculated using weights equal to one for countries and areas with less than 10,000 seafarers, and two for countries and areas with 10,000 or more seafarers, as required by the 1991 resolution. The median is 45.5 (cumulated weight) corresponding approximately to the values between Italy (US\$ 573.98) and Malaysia (US\$ 575.28).
