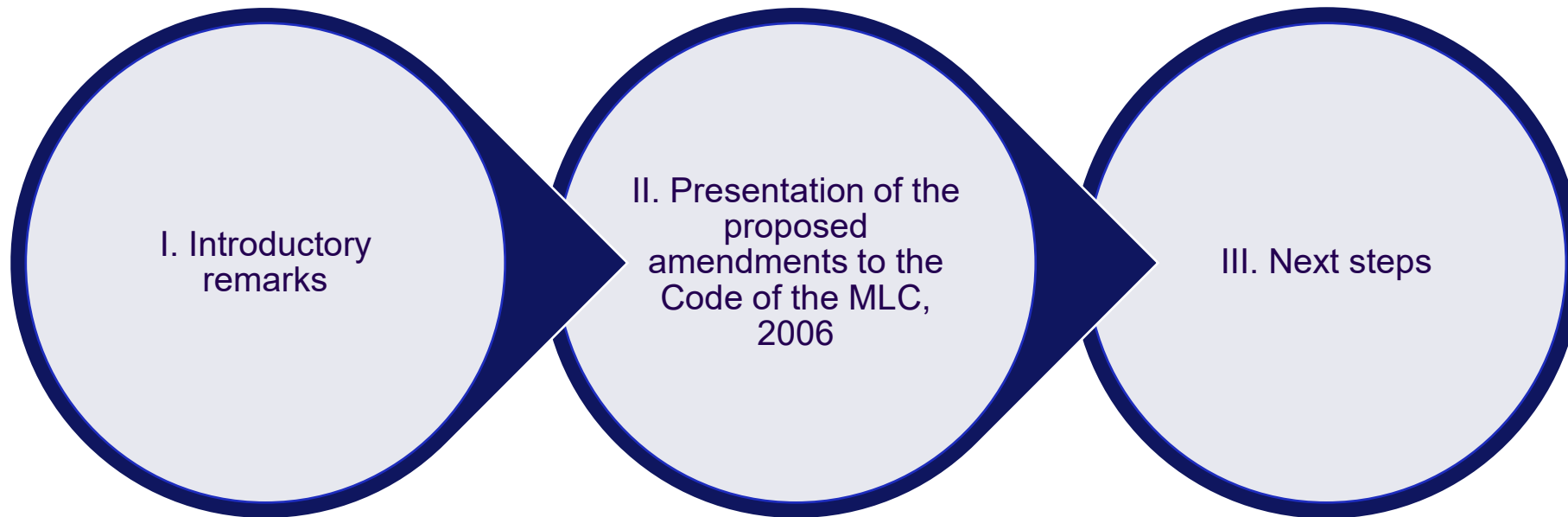




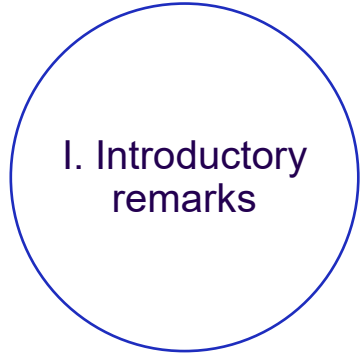

Practical guidelines for the Zoom meeting



▶ **Interpretation is available in English, French and Spanish.**

- Ensure the language you intend to speak in is the same language you are listening to, by selecting that language in the interpretation menu (located at the bottom of your screen).

Procedure to amend the Code (Article XV, MLC, 2006)

Submission of proposals for amendments

Communication to all Members of the Organization for comments

Summary of comments prepared before the STC

STC: submission of amendments and sub-amendments

Adoption and transmittal to the International Labour Conference for approval

Notification to ratifying Members: two years to express disagreement

Entry into force 6 months after (unless large disagreement)



- ▶ **15 February:** further information on the format of the meeting
- ▶ **28 February:** deadline for reception of written comments from Members on the proposed amendments (by email to: MLCamend@ilo.org)
- ▶ **Mid-March:** publication of synthesis document
- ▶ **6-7 April:** preparatory session for governments
- ▶ **4-13 May:** Fourth Meeting of the STC – Part II
