Report of the Director-General

Sixth Supplementary Report: Composition of the Committee on Freedom of Association

- 1. The Committee on Freedom of Association has a fixed membership of three regular members and three deputy members from each of the three groups. Appointments are made by the Governing Body in an individual capacity at the beginning of each term of office of the Governing Body and for the same duration. The current composition of the Committee on freedom of Association was decided by the Governing Body at its 330th Session (June 2017).¹
- 2. By a communication dated 2 November 2018, Ms Graciela Sosa (Argentina), Government regular member of the Committee on Freedom of Association, has informed the Office that she will resign from the Committee on Freedom of Association as from 31 December 2018. The Government group has nominated Mr Aurelio Linero Mendoza (Panama) to replace Ms Sosa as regular member of the Committee.

Draft decision

3. The Governing Body appointed Mr Aurelio Linero Mendoza (Panama) as Government regular member of the Committee on Freedom of Association with effect from 1 January 2019, in replacement of Ms Graciela Sosa (Argentina) for the remainder of the period of office of the Governing Body for 2017–20.
