# Third supplementary report: Documents submitted for information only

- 1. As part of the reform package adopted at its 310th Session (March 2011), <sup>1</sup> the Governing Body decided that documents identified as "For information" would be published on the Governing Body website but would not be intended for discussion, unless the tripartite screening group decides otherwise at the request of a member of the Governing Body. <sup>2</sup> These documents for information include reports of the Officers of the Governing Body with decisions made under delegated authority. <sup>3</sup>
