Discussing research findings on Migrant Domestic Workers in Paraguay- Argentina corridor

Buenos Aires, Argentina, 25 November 2014

A national workers' workshop was held in Buenos Aires, Argentina, 25 November 2014, with participation of representatives of the main trade union confederation in Argentina - General Confederation of Labour (CGL) and affiliated to it domestic workers organization - Unión de Personal Auxiliar de Casa Particular (UPACP). A platform for action in Argentina was defined upon the validation of baseline studies in the corridor, conducted under the auspices of the Global Action Programme on Migrant Domestic Workers and their Families (GAP-MDW).

Participants provided their feedback and produced recommendations. The discussion of the main findings set the grounds to define a platform for action of the UPACP on migration and domestic work, including renovated efforts to affiliate MDWs to the UPACP. Representatives of CGL and UPACP discussed the bi-national workers' agreement and action plan (established in September 2014 in Santiago) and prioritized actions for its implementation at national level.
