The programme has been operational in 22 countries, reaching directly or indirectly over 182 million workers by building knowledge, raising awareness, and strengthening institutions and legal and policy frameworks to foster a safe and healthy working environment.

This catalogue compiles over 60 publications produced in the framework of the flagship programme as of 2022. The resources cover various topics related to safety and health at work from a global perspective or focusing on specific countries and/or sector issues.



Exposure to mercury in the world of work: A review of the evidence and key priority actions



- Understanding the potential scale of the problem in terms of occupational health impacts.


The GHS in the world of work: Mapping synergies


Improving OSH for young workers: A self-training package


Safety and health for young workers: Factsheet for employers







- Implement a methodology for assessing drivers and constraints for OSH improvement in selected global supply chains.
- Design tailored evidence-based interventions that can effectively prevent occupational injuries and diseases in a given global supply chain and beyond.

The kit comprises a guide for implementers and a set of tools adaptable to each project and country context and suitable for each step (value chain selection, mapping, analysis, and intervention design). The methodology was successfully implemented in agriculture, construction and textile/garment global supply chains in seven countries (*see case studies on the next pages*).







These synthesis reviews compile evidence on occupational safety and health (OSH) vulnerability profiles and on drivers and constraints for OSH improvements in agricultural global supply chains and in garment factories. The assessments discuss challenges and opportunities that are common or unique across sectors and countries and inform the development of new and improved strategies to strengthen OSH in agricultural and textile/garment global supply chains. The reviews also identify persistent research gaps and provide recommendations for future studies.


Food and agriculture global value chains: Drivers and constraints for OSH improvement





The case studies document and analyse occupational safety and health (OSH) measures and actions taken by stakeholders within selected global supply chains to prevent exposure to and transmission of COVID-19 in workplaces in three Vision Zero Fund project countries. The focus is on measures and actions implemented in the following supply chains: coffee in Colombia, garment/ textiles in Ethiopia, and garment in Myanmar. Research findings provide evidence of how OSH measures mitigated the effects of the pandemic. The studies also identify entry points for designing effective plans to ensure safer and healthier supply chains and support the development of policies and strategies to address future pandemics.






Improving safety and health in MSMEs: An overview of initiatives and delivery mechanisms

The report identifies and analyses examples of support mechanisms and incentives that governments and other actors use in various contexts to enable outreach to micro, small and medium-sized enterprises (MSMEs) and promote safe and healthy working environments. The report also describes ILO tools and programmes focused on increasing productivity in MSMEs, particularly those with the primary objective of improving OSH. The report is complemented by [**five case studies**](#) on safety and health in MSMEs conducted in Cameroon, Colombia, Indonesia, the Philippines and Tunisia. Based on the findings, a "how to" guide was created to support governments, employers' and workers' organizations and other stakeholders in cooperating in developing an adapted strategy to improve OSH conditions in MSMEs (*see next page*). It has been successfully pilot-tested in Mozambique and Zambia.


Support kit for developing occupational safety and health legislation






Mapping of household and establishment surveys to collect data on OSH



Reducing or eliminating exposure and health loss attributable to occupational risk factors is essential to achieving the United Nations 2030 Agenda of Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), specifically SDG3 and SDG8. This requires monitoring such exposures and health loss at country, regional and global levels. For this purpose, the World Health Organization (WHO) and the International Labour Organization (ILO) have produced their first Joint Estimates of the Work-related Burden of Disease and Injury. This Global Monitoring Report describes the objectives, data sources and methods of the new interagency estimates and reports the WHO/ILO Joint Estimates generated in this cycle.


Collecting data and measuring KPIs on OSH interventions: A guidebook for implementers




