

▶ Instructions for delegates at the International Labour Conference on electronic votes in plenary

▶ Important note on voting sessions in June 2023

There will be at least four electronic voting sessions in plenary (requiring 27 votes to be cast), organized during the 111th Session of the International Labour Conference, provisionally scheduled for 12 and 15 (or 16) June 2023.

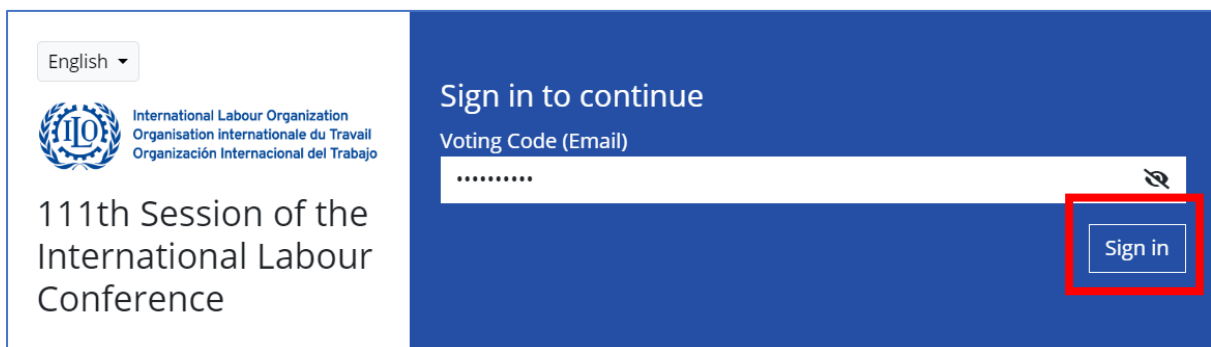
Please note that, apart from the vote on the possible adoption of the Recommendation on Apprenticeships, scheduled for 15 (or 16) June, the following voting sessions are planned:

Voting Sessions	Date	Votes to be cast
Programme and Budget for 2024-25	... June	One question
Convention and Recommendation on occupational safety and health (OSH)	12 June	Two questions
Abrogation and withdrawal of maritime instruments	12 June	24 questions

1. An email will be dispatched to your email address (the email address that was provided at the point of accreditation – please ensure that your email address is accurate and working). The email address used to send the email is “**International Labour Organization** <no-reply@mail.assembly-voting.com>”. It contains an embedded link to the voting system as well as the voting code. Please click on **Go to login**.

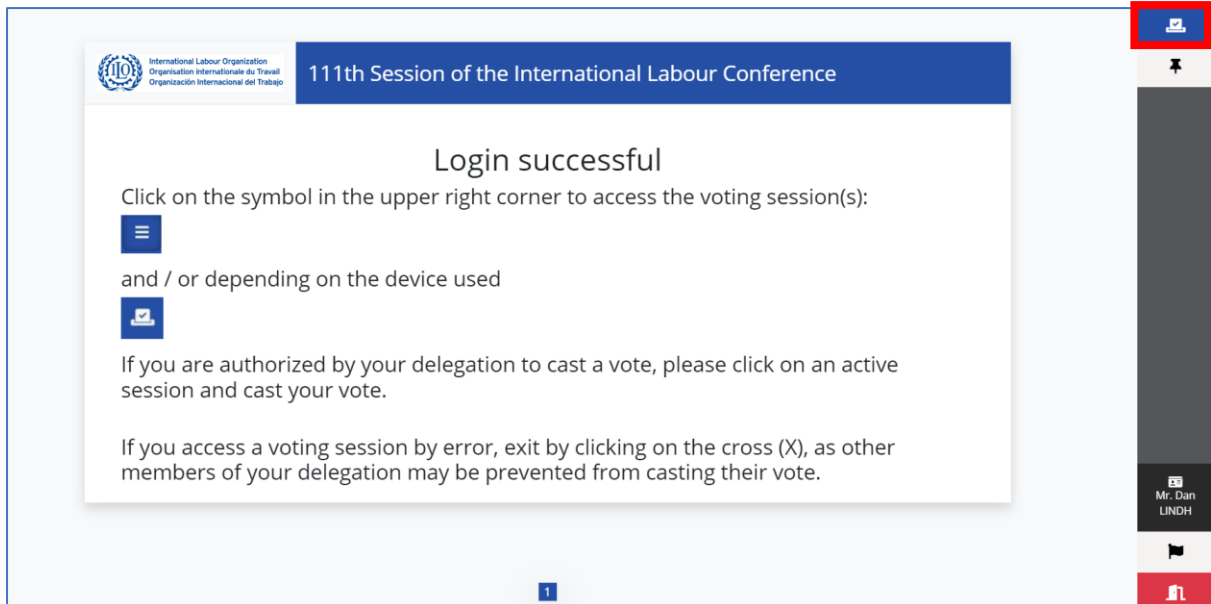


2. The link brings you to the authentication page. The voting code is already pre-filled in the page. Please click on **Sign in** to proceed.

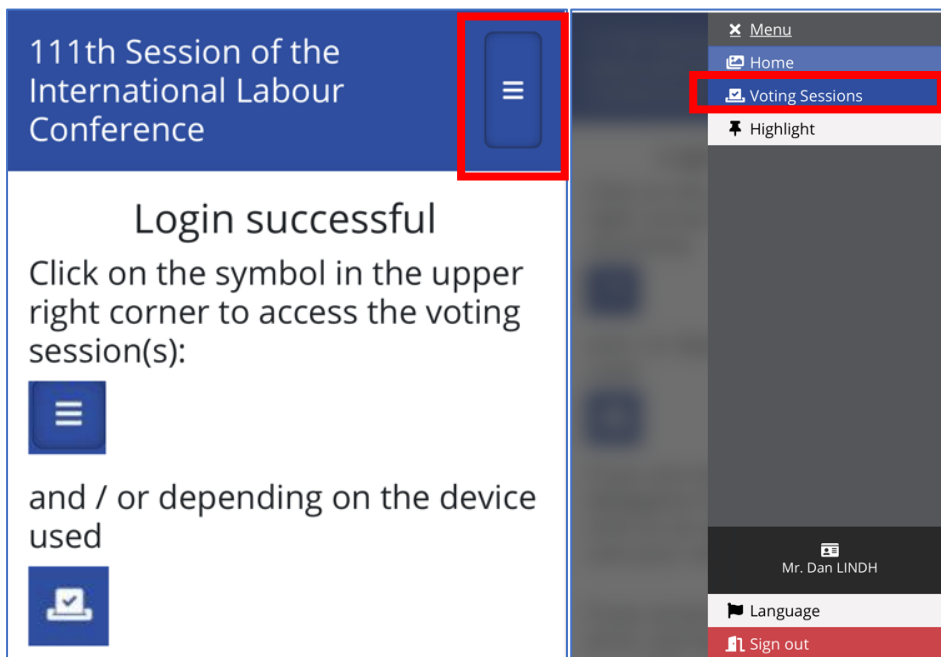


3. On the home page, the voting sessions can be accessed by clicking the button representing a ballot box or three lines. Please click on **Voting Sessions** to proceed.

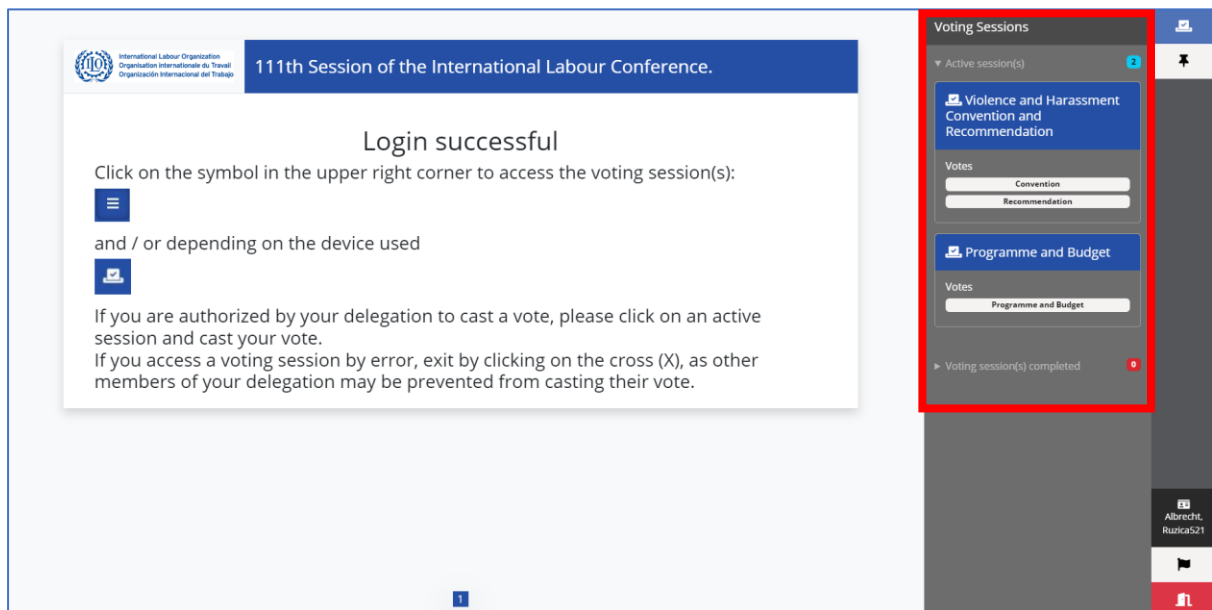
(a) PC or Laptop view

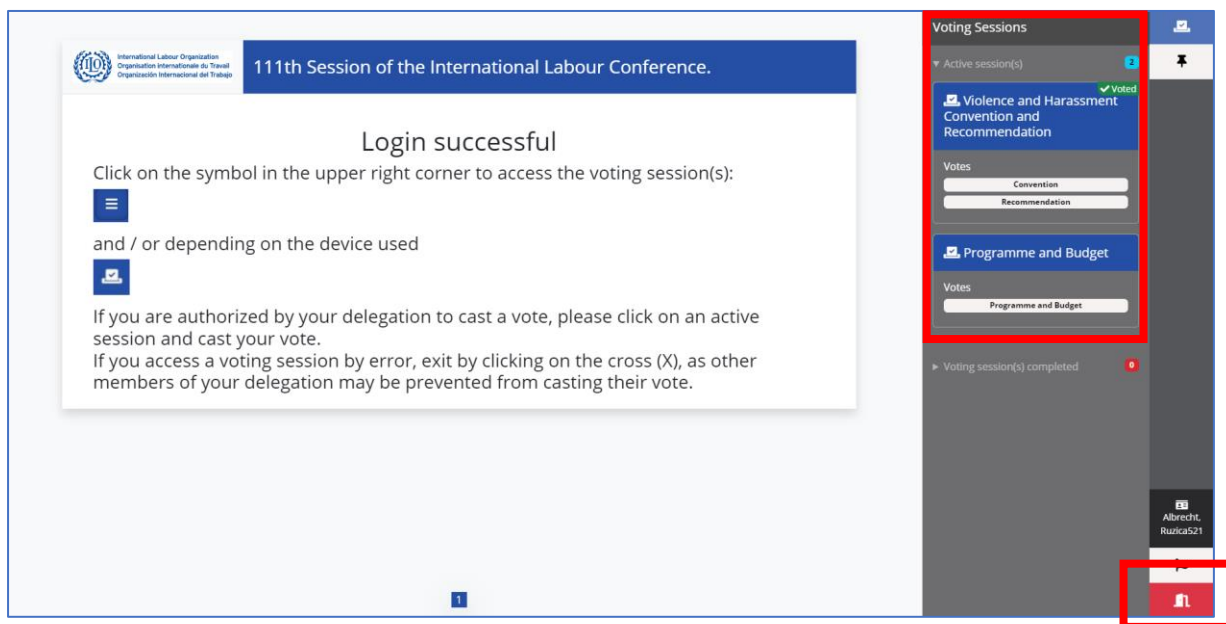
